



# Elementary Uniform Guidelines

2026-2027 School Year

# TK-5 FORMAL WEAR UNIFORM OPTIONS

Formal Uniform attire is required on Fridays that coincide with Assembly days on the ParentSquare calendar. Students are welcome to wear formal attire on any school day, should they choose to do so. Additionally, teachers may request formal attire for specific field trips or special events as needed.

- **Option #1:** OCASA plaid skort OR gray skort, white Oxford dress shirt (OCASA logo optional) tucked in with OCASA plaid tie. Skort no more than 4 inches above knee



- **Option #2:** OCASA plaid or gray skirt, white Oxford dress shirt (OCASA logo optional) tucked in with OCASA plaid tie. Modesty shorts or leggings required under skirt. Skirt no more than 4 inches above the knee.



- **Option #3:** OCASA plaid jumper, white peter pan collar blouse (OCASA logo optional) with OCASA black cross tie. Modesty shorts or leggings required under dress. Dress length no more than 4 inches above knee.



- **Option #4:** Gray smart-casual trouser, solid color black belt with tucked in Oxford dress shirt (OCASA logo optional) and OCASA plaid tie.



*Please note: It will be announced if weather permits for gray smart-casual shorts on Formal Day (instead of the gray pants)*

# TK-5 STANDARD UNIFORM ATTIRE OPTIONS

Standard Attire - Worn daily from Monday to Friday unless it is a Friday Assembly Day where Formal Attire is required. Students may also wear Formal Attire on Standard Uniform Days. On Fridays, students may wear Spirit Wear with a Standard Uniform bottom.

- **Top Options:** *(These can be purchased at Lands' End to have OCASA logo or you can find the same color/style elsewhere without logo)*
  - #1: Polo shirt in solid colored royal blue, gray or white
  - #2: Long Sleeve polo in royal blue, gray or white
- **Bottom Options:** *(These can be purchased at Lands' End to have OCASA plaid or you can find the same solid color/cut/style elsewhere)*
  - #1: OCASA Plaid Skort
  - #2: OCASA Gray Skort
  - #3: OCASA plaid pleated skirt (Gray or black modesty/bike shorts required underneath)
  - #4: Gray smart-casual trouser (black belt optional since polo doesn't need to be tucked in)
  - #5: Black smart-casual trouser (black belt optional since polo doesn't need to be tucked in)
  - #6: Gray smart-casual shorts
  - #7: Black smart-casual shorts

## Skirts / Skorts / Shorts

Must be appropriate size at the waist and no more than 4 inches above the knee. Modesty shorts must be worn under skirts. Leggings can be worn under, but cannot be worn alone as a pant.

## Pants and Shorts

Must be worn appropriately at the waist and be of appropriate size. Denim like material, yoga, jeggings, leggings, gym shorts / basketball shorts, or skinny jean style pants are not allowed. Pants and shorts with cargo-style pockets are not allowed.



# TK-5 FORMAL & STANDARD WEAR ACCESSORY OPTIONS

Formal Uniform attire is required on Fridays that coincide with Assembly days on the ParentSquare calendar.

- **Misc. Accessory Options:** *(These items may be purchased through Lands' End or you may find the same color/ style elsewhere)*

- Socks in solid colored gray, white, or black (no royal blue socks on formal day)
- Shoes (close-toed) in solid colored royal blue, gray, white, black
- Hair Accessories in OCASA plaid, royal blue or solid colored gray, white or black



- **Optional Colder Weather Add-ons:** *(These items can be purchased through Lands' End or you may find the same color/ style elsewhere. Logo not required)*

- Jacket, Sweater or cardigan in solid colored gray, white or black (no royal blue jackets on formal day)
- V-neck Sweater Vest in solid colored black (only color option)
- Under Shirt to be worn underneath a required formal Collar Shirt (long or short sleeve for warmth) in solid colored gray, white or black (no royal blue under shirt on formal day)
- Tights or Knee Hi Socks to be worn underneath a required formal OCASA Plaid Skort, Skirt or Dress in solid colored gray, white or black (no royal blue tights or knee hi socks on formal day)

- **Shoe Options:**

- Shoes in solid colored royal blue, gray, white, black
- Sturdy, closed-toe footwear is required.

# TK-5 SPIRIT WEAR UNIFORM ATTIRE OPTIONS

Worn on Fridays or on Field Trip Days when instructed by Teacher. On non-assembly Fridays, students may also choose to wear Formal Attire or the Standard Uniform

- **Top Options:** (These may be purchased at [www.shopocasa.org](http://www.shopocasa.org) or through PTSA fundraiser with the OCASA logo. PLAIN solid band color t shirts may be purchased elsewhere with NO logo)
  - #1: Spirit Wear shirt in your STUDENTS BAND COLOR
  - #2: Spirit wear shirt from past OCASA event or year
- **Bottom Options:** (These may be purchased at Lands' End or you may find the same solid color, cut, or style elsewhere).
  - #1: OCASA Plaid Skort
  - #2: OCASA Gray Skort
  - #3: OCASA plaid pleated skirt (Gray or black modesty/bike shorts required underneath)
  - #4: Gray smart-casual trouser (black belt optional since polo doesn't need to be tucked in)
  - #5: Black smart-casual trouser (black belt optional since polo doesn't need to be tucked in)
  - #6: Gray smart-casual shorts
  - #7: Black smart-casual shorts

(SAME ACCESSORIES APPLY AS ON STANDARD & FORMAL DAYS)

## Skirts / Skorts / Shorts

Must be appropriate size at the waist and no more than 4 inches above the knee. Modesty shorts must be worn under skirts. Leggings can be worn under, but cannot be worn alone as a pant.

## Pants and Shorts

Must be worn appropriately at the waist and be of appropriate size. Denim like material, yoga, jeggings, leggings, gym shorts / basketball shorts, or skinny jean style pants are not allowed. Pants and shorts with cargo-style pockets are not allowed.
